<b>Leadership</b>	Minimum of 3 months or 2 events as Team Leader within Green Chief	Experience as departmental head within festivals
<b>Motivational</b>	Ability to motivate volunteers and team leaders to achieve set targets	Proven motivation track record in previous role
<b>Communication</b>	Ability to communicate vocally and written form in a clear, positive manner	Experience in teaching or teaching qualification (TESOL, Ba or Dip Ed)
<b>Recycling Knowledge</b>	Previous experience of working in a recycling or waste facility or festival department	Waste auditing experience
<b>Event Management</b>	Basic knowledge of how an event operates	Event management qualification (Dip or Ba)
<b>Administration</b>	Well organized and able to communicate task prioritization	Desire to learn festival specific programs.
<b>Environmental Knowledge</b>	Desire to learn about environmental impacts of events	Prior implementation of environmental knowledge through study or work (Dip or BSc)
<b>Problem Solving</b>	Previous problem solving skills within an event situation	Experience with crisis management situations
<b>Physical Fitness</b>	Must be able to move around uneven event sites, bend down and lift items	Superhuman powers
<b>Technical Qualities</b>	Safe working knowledge of basic tools	Experience in power tool use and vehicle maintenance
<b>First Aid</b>	Current First Aid Certificate	Senior first aid certificate and/or resuscitation certificate
<b>Commitment</b>	Commitment to working 8-12 hour shifts during an event.	Commitment to pre and post event set up/pack down
<b>Driving License</b>	Full, clean driving license. Ability to reverse a trailer.	LR, HR or Telehandler licence
